'Pepsi' squad stampedes to Reisinger BAM win

The team captained by Polish transplant Jacek Pszczola, last among the qualifiers for the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams final, took off like a rocket at the start of the second final session on Sunday and emerged with a win by three quarters of a board in arguably the toughest game on the ACBL calendar.

Pszczola, known more familiarly as Pepsi-Cola, was playing with Gary Cohler, Joe Grue and Curtis Cheek. He has been living in North Carolina, waiting to get a green card in order to play full-time in the U.S. He has competed for the U.S. in the last two team trials.

Second in the Reisinger went to Russ Ekeblad, Chip Martel, Lew Stansby, Fred Gitelman and Brad Moss. The Nick Nickell team (Richard Freeman, Bob Hamman, Paul Soloway, Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell), bidding for a third straight Reisinger victory, finished in third place.

The Pszczola team, with Reese Milner as unofficial non-playing captain, were at the bottom of the 10-team field – with zero carryover – starting play on

Kasday team captures North American Swiss

The team captained by Tony Kasday lost its first two matches, but recovered to win the rest to take the Bill Keohane North American Swiss Teams. The Lynch team was leading for the first six rounds, but Kasday blitzed them in the seventh round to score 20-0 Victory Points.

With one round to play, Lynch had 112 VPs, Kasday 111.67 and the Mahaffey team had 111.14 VPs. Kasday won the last round over Mahaffey by a score of 17 to 3 VPs to move ahead of the Lynch team who lost their match 14-6. Kasday finished with 128 VPs, Lynch had 118 and Mahaffey scored 114 for third place.

The winners are Kasday, Thorlakur Jonsson, Sigurbjorn Haraldsson, Disa Eythorsdottir, Bjarni Einarsson and Jon Baldursson.

The second place team was Carol Lynch, Mike Passell, Eddie Wold, Dennis Dawson, Larry Cohen and David Berkowitz.

The third place team was Jim Mahaffey, Mark Lair, Fredrick Nystrom, Peter Bertheau, Fu Zhong and Zhao Jie.

Hamman earns third Player of Year award



Bob Hamman, the winner of the first Player of the Year award in 1990, has earned his third award, thanks to his team's strong finish in the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams.

The Player of the Year is the person who earns the most masterpoints in events that pay platinum points – NABC+ events.

Hamman finished 2006 with an unofficial total of 773.03 platinum points, to 758.25 for Jeff Meckstroth, himself a former Player of the Year. The two are members of the Nick Nickell squad that has dominated team play in ACBL tournaments for more than a decade.

In third place in the annual race was Bjorn Fallenius, who had taken the lead in the contest with three days to go in the NABC. His team did not make it to the final of the Reisinger, however. Fallenius finished with 722 platinum points.

The rest of the top 10 (unofficial totals) are Eric Rodwell, 718.08; Paul Soloway, 694.98; Joe Grue, 605.80; Fulvio Fantoni, 591.71; Drew Casen, 568.16; Claudio Nunes, 567.98, and Curtis Cheek, 561.88.
