## Fantoni first in Mixed BAM

The squad of Fulvio Fantoni, Donna Compton, Petra Hamman and Hemant Lall triumphed last night in the Chicago Mixed Board-a-Match Teams. The Fulvio team scored 36.89 — 16.50 in the afternoon and 18.00 in the evening with a carryover of 2.39.

In second with 34.94 was Richard Zeckhauser, Mildred Breed, Eddie Wold and Disa Eythorsdottir.

Fantoni, of Rome, Italy, is the reigning World Open Pairs champ with regular partner Claudio Nunes. In the Mixed BAM, Fantoni played with Compton of Dallas TX. This is the first NABC victory for Compton.

Hamman, also of Dallas, played with Lall, of Plano TX.

"I only win playing with Hammans," quipped Lall, referring to his previous NABC victory with Petra's husband Bob in the 1992 Life Master Pairs.

Petra Hamman was a member of the winning Women's Team Olympiad in 2000, and has four previous NABC titles.

### Fastest guns in the West: Hurd, Wooldridge

John Hurd and Joel Wooldridge won the four-session NABC Fast Pairs by more than a full board, finishing with 1284.43 on a 38 top.

This is the first NABC victory for Hurd of Charleston SC, and the second for Wooldridge of Buffalo NY. Wooldridge won the 1997 IMP Pairs with Tom Carmichael.

"We were the fastest and the bestest," said a grinning Wooldridge as partner Hurd rolled his

eyes and laughed.

Hurd and Wooldridge, both 24, have been playing together for four years. They are members of the World Junior Team champions, and they will defend their title in Paris later this year.

In second with 1237.99 were Ed Schulte of Tampa FL and Joseph Godefrin of Sarasota FL. Third were Richard Miller of Raleigh NC and Jerry Helms of Charlotte NC with 1193.44.

# Senior slam

The team led by Carolyn Bjorklund won the Senior Swiss Teams earlier this week. Bjorklund was playing with Ed Barlow, Evan Bailey, Arnie Fisher and Fred Hamilton.

Fisher submitted this deal from the second final session. The Bjorklund team was playing the leaders at the time, the foursome of Aram Bedros, Leo Bell, David Lindop and Marshall Miles. Bedros defeated Bjorklund in their match by 3 IMPs. The result of this deal kept the Bedros win from being quite a bit larger; had Fisher failed, Bedros — who finished second overall by 3 Victory Points to Bjorklund — would probably have won the event.

Hamilton's transfer sequence was mildly slam-mish in their methods, so Fisher decided to press on with his excellent controls. The contract, however, is tenuous.

Lindop led the ♠9, and Fisher decided that West wasn't leading from three low trumps, so he played low from dummy. Miles won the king and returned a low diamond.

Fisher could count 10 tricks at this point — five spades, two hearts, two diamonds and a club. He needed the diamond finesse to work, which would bring the total to 11. How to find a 12th trick?

There are several possible squeeze ideas that might allow declarer to get home. The low diamond shift by East suggested diamond length on declarer's right. If East was also guarding K-x-x-x in clubs, the run of the spades would put Miles under severe pressure.

So declarer won the ♦A and cashed the ♠J. With trumps revealed to be 2-2, Fisher began to work on the assumption that East's pattern was 2-2-5-4, 2-2-4-5 or perhaps 2-3-5-3. Two more rounds of trump forced two discards from Miles who selected a diamond and a heart. At this point, Fisher decided he could switch gears for a moment and explore hearts. If East's original heart holding was 10-x (surely Miles wouldn't have discarded a low heart from Q-x), declarer could cash the high hearts and take the ruffing finesse against Lindop's ♥Q, which is exactly what happened.

With the diamond finesse working, Fisher scored up his slam for a 13-IMP gain.

# New Life Master

Jean Stewart of Virginia Beach VA went over the top by winning a bracketed knockout. Her teammates were Larry and Ginni Ryan of Virginia Beach and Tish Kernochan of Long Beach.

Lew Stansby, whose team was well behind at the time, attempted to set up a swing by opening on just his three jacks – and a four-card suit! – in third position. Michael Rosenberg had a powerhouse, so he doubled, intending to clarify later. Zia responded in his five-card suit, but this showed no particular values. Nevertheless Rosenberg leaped to 3NT, saying effectively, “I have a good chance at this contract no matter how bad your hand is.” Zia realized he had far more than Rosenberg might expect, so he issued an invitation by bidding 4NT. Rosenberg was happy to accept.

All Rosenberg needed was a reasonable break in either black suit. Spades didn't work out, but clubs did and he scored up his slam.

Adam Zmudzinski made a more normal opening bid here – 2♥. Apparently those spades in the West hand were something special, because Cezary Balicki, like Stansby, bid them. Peter Weichsel doubled and Zmudzinski bid his second suit. This rode around to Weichsel who, like Rosenberg, leaped to 3NT. Sontag didn't feel he had enough to invite, so he passed. That was 13 IMPs to the team captained by Roy Welland.

The shoe was on the other foot on the next deal.

Zia raised Rosenberg's diamonds and Rosenberg invited 3NT by bidding hearts. Zia was happy to accept. This would have been a fine contract except for one thing – Stansby found the killing heart lead. Zia had to give up the lead to set up diamonds, and the defense quickly cashed their hearts and the ♣A to put the contract two down.

Alan Sontag rebid his spades rather than raising diamonds at his second turn.
