Landen sextet victorious in Reisinger Teams

The team captained by Stephen Landen won 2.5 out of 3 boards on the last round to claim victory in the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams.

Landen was playing with Pratap Rajadhyaksha; their teammates were Dan Morse-Bobby Wolff and Adam Wildavsky-Doug Doub.

With one round to go, three teams were closely bunched: Landen, Malcolm Brachman (Chris Compton, Mike Passell, Claudio Nunes, Fulvio Fantoni) and Nick Nickell (Richard Freeman, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell, Bob Hamman, Paul Soloway).

Brachman split their round – 1.5 to 1.5 – while Nickell got only 1 on the round.

That put Landen on top with 33.14, followed by Richard Schwartz (Michael Becker, David Berkowitz, Larry Cohen, Zia Mahmood, Michael Rosenberg) with 31.12 and Nickell with 30.65.

Landen and Rajadhyaksha claimed their second North American championship as a partnership; they won Open Pairs II at the 2000 Spring NABC in Cincinnati. Landen won the same event at the 1990 Spring NABC in Fort Worth.

Morse and Wolff won their second North American championship at this tournament – they were members of the winning Senior Knockout Teams earlier in the week. Morse, District 16 representative to the ACBL Board of Directors, was named ACBL Honor-

The team captained by Mark Gordon locked up victory in the North American Swiss Teams early – with one round to play, they had 128 Victory Points and could not be caught.

Gordon was playing with Richard Zucker, Winthrop Allegaert, Jaggy Shivdasani, Markland Molson and Boris Baran. Their final VP total was 138.

Robert Holman, Marc Jacobus, Gaylor Kasle, Geoff Hampson and Eric Greco were second with 125.19 VPs. Hampson and Greco had a fine tournament – they won the Life Master Open Pairs earlier in the tournament.

Larry Cohen becomes 2002 Player of Year

By placing second in the final event of the year – the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams – Larry Cohen of Boca Raton FL earned enough platinum points to become the 2002 Player of the Year in the ACBL. He also had a second in the Life Master Pairs.

Jeff Meckstroth of Tampa FL also leaped past Norberto Bocchi of Italy, yesterday's leader, by placing third in the Reisinger.

Meckstroth finished approximately 54 points behind Cohen. Bocchi was the only other player to win more than 700 platinum points.

Double winner Morse wins Herman Trophy

Dan Morse was the victor in the race for the Herman Trophy, awarded to the player who scores the most masterpoints at the Fall NABC. Morse won two events – the Reisinger and the Senior Teams – and this accounted for 365 of his 388.81 points. His partner in those twin triumphs – Bobby Wolff – didn't score quite as many points in other events and came in second. Larry Cohen, who became Player of the Year, was third.

ary Member in 1989. He is a World Bridge Federation World Master and ACBL Grand Life Master. He won the World Senior Teams in 2000 and has several high finishes in international competition. He has now won nine North American championships.

Wolff, former District 16 director and former president of the ACBL and the WBF, has won 11 world titles – seven Bermuda Bowls, World Mixed Teams,

Open Pairs, Open Teams and World Senior Teams. He is the only player to have won world championships in five different categories.

He has won 29 North American championships – this is his eighth Reisinger victory.

Wildavsky claimed his third national title – he has victories in the Blue Ribbon Pairs in 1992 and 1997.

Doub also won his third national championship – he won the Open Board-a-Match Teams in St. Louis in 1997 and the North American Open Pairs Flight A in 2001.
