## Bridge Hall of Fame adds eight members

In the fourth election since the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame was reborn, eight new members joined the bridge elite, swelling the ranks to 41.

New members are Billy Eisenberg, Mary Jane Farrell and Dorothy Truscott, elected as living members; John Gerber, Alfonse "Sonny" Moyses and Peter Pender, deceased members; Alvin Landy, recipient of the *von Zedtwitz Award*, and Dave Treadwell, recipient of the *Blackwood Award*. Induction ceremonies for the new members will take place during to the 1998 Summer NABC in Chicago.

*Brief biographies of the winners of Alvin Landy, winner of the von Zedtwitz Award, and Dave Treadwell, winner of the Blackwood Award, are featured nearby. The new living members will be featured tomorrow, and the deceased members on Saturday.*

The *Blackwood Award* was established to honor bridge players, living or deceased, who contributed to the game in areas outside bridge-playing expertise. The *von Zedtwitz Award* was established to honor a deceased person who contributed to bridge as a player.

The ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame, which contains portraits of all members, is located on the fourth floor of the ACBL Headquarters building in Memphis.

An ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame Committee was established in 1994 to oversee development of the institution. Committee members are chairman Larry Cohen (Florida), Cecil Cook, Kerri Sanborn, Alan Truscott and Steve Weinstein. The nominating com-

## 90% last round wins Mixed Pairs for Canadian duo

A Toronto pair who had never played together before scored 90% on their last round to win the NABC Mixed Pairs by half a board.

Joan Eaton and Leslie Amoils scored 2984.37 matchpoints to edge out runners-up Barbara Lehman and Craig Jacobson, who had 2949.01 points. Top on a board was 90.

The two scored 48% and 55% in the qualifying rounds and made the cut with a minimal carryover. Yesterday's games were 62% and 64% -- "we did them in the right order," said Eaton.

Eaton and Amoils had a huge last round to take the championship. The Canadians bid and made a small slam on the first board -- good for 74 matchpoints. Next, Amoils scored up 5♦ doubled for 88 matchpoints.

Amoils has lived in Canada for the last seven years but is originally from South Africa. "I love Canada but in my heart I'm a South African. I always will be," said Amoils.

## Jackpot winners divide \$3840 pool

Ninety-six pairs of the 276 entered in yesterday's Stratified Open Pairs opted to enter the Jackpot competition. This provided a pool of \$3840 to be divided among the jackpot winners and the lucky winner of a drawing.

The big winners were Jan Shane of Las Vegas and Peter Grover, Pittsburgh, overall winners of the event. Their portion of the jackpot amounted to \$2145.

The winners of Flight B, Yifan Yang of Oak Park IL and Amitabh Dave of Urbana IL, also were in the jackpot. They will collect \$777.

In Flight C, the first and second-place finishers did not go into the Jackpot, so the third-place finishers will get the \$534 prize. They are Bill McGeary and Sheryl Clough of Burien WA.

The remaining \$384 will go to the winner of the drawing that will take place at the start of today's events at 1 p.m. The other prizes also will be awarded at this time -- it was necessary to hold back the prizes until the deadline for corrections passed.

## Rapee moves into Vanderbilt quarterfinal

The team captained by George Rapee led from the start against Marshall Miles and his team of giant killers and moved into today's quarterfinal of the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams.

Rapee (John Solodar, Bill Eisenberg, Russ

## A diabolical opening lead

Hendrik Sharples found the only opening lead that could possibly give declarer a problem on this grand slam, Board 29 from Tuesday evening.

The bidding certainly showed that Rhoda Walsh, Hendrik's partner, had nothing to contribute to the defense. This is how Hendrik was thinking: "East opened the bidding and later showed two aces in response to Blackwood. Perhaps he has the ♥A. Maybe if I lead my deuce of hearts, declarer will have a problem." No sooner thought than done.

Usually you don't lead away from a king against a grand -- in fact, usually you lead a trump and make declarer do all the work. But a trump lead here would do no good -- when diamonds fail to break 3-3, declarer would be forced to take the successful heart finesse.

But Hendrik's lead of the ♥2 really put it to the declarer. If diamonds were breaking 3-3, he didn't need the finesse. And anyway, who ever leads away from a king against a grand slam? Clearly Hendrik did NOT have the king. So declarer went up with the ace and had to go down one when the diamonds failed to break 3-3.

## Upsetting news

The final quarter of the Nickell-Miles match featured a nice piece of bidding judgment by Mark Bartusek. Over a 14-16 notrump, Mark held:

♠ A K 10 8 6 4 3    ♥ A K 10 5    ♦ J    ♣ 4

What would be your choice?

Mark could have jumped to 4♠, but instead he tried 2♣ for the majors. Marshall Miles bid 2♥. Now Mark tried 3♠, and when Marshall converted to 4♥, he passed.

Marshall had the following hand:

♠ 2    ♥ 8 6 4 2    ♦ Q 9 4 3    ♣ Q 8 6 2

Since both spades and hearts broke 3-2, Marshall had no problem taking 10 tricks. This was a 10-IMP pickup against 4♠ down one at the other table -- one IMP more than the margin of victory.

# HALL OF FAME

## Dave Treadwell

When you see Dave Treadwell at a tournament, it's wise to prepare yourself to suffer through --- or enjoy, depending on your taste --- a bad joke.

The 85-year-old tournament veteran is notorious for his seemingly endless store of puns and gags that he manages to relate in perfectly deadpan fashion. Despite Treadwell's reputation, you often don't know you've been had until you hear the punch line.

There are, however, a couple of serious sides to Treadwell, a retired chemical engineer.

First, as an expert bridge player, the Wilmington DE resident maintains the solemn view that it is his obligation to take as many tricks as possible when at the bridge table. In so doing, he has earned the rank of Grand Life Master (with more than 20,000 masterpoints) and has represented the U.S. in international competition on several occasions.

Second, Treadwell is quite serious when it comes to serving the bridge community. His dedication earned him accolades as ACBL Honorary Member of the Year in 1985. Now he also has a place in the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame as the 1998 winner of the *Blackwood Award* as an ACBL member who has made major contributions to bridge outside of bridge-playing expertise.

Treadwell served as chairman of the ACBL Board of Governors from 1979 through 1981 and was co-chairman of the ACBL Appeals Committee from 1975 to 1991. He is a past-president of Unit 190 (Delaware) and of District 4.

When Treadwell first started playing, few had even heard of contract bridge. The game he played as a youngster growing up in New Jersey was known as auction bridge.

It all started when, at the age of 15, Treadwell was recruited as a fourth. He was immediately smitten. By the time he enrolled at MIT in Cambridge MA in 1929, contract bridge had taken off, and Treadwell liked it even better than auction. He played in his first duplicate in 1931 at the Boston Chess Club.

"I avidly read the Culbertson Blue Book on bidding," Treadwell says. "I knew it by heart."

As he became better and better at bridge, Treadwell found himself at the same bridge clubs as some of the future stars of the game, including Billy Seamon and his sister Edith (now Freilich) and Sidney Silodor.

Naturally competitive, Treadwell always plays in the top event for which he is eligible. He likes the mental stimulation. "Bridge has helped me as much as anything in maintaining my mental faculties," he says. That includes the capacity for remembering --- and sometimes creating --- jokes. Here are a couple of stories that involve good friends of his.

He was playing with the late Jim Becker, and Jim raised Dave to 2♥ on three jacks and out. Dave drove all the way to slam, and as Becker was putting down the dummy, he said, "You're always telling jokes -- can't you take a joke?" As usual Dave had the last laugh -- he made 6♥ doubled.

Then there was the time he was playing with the late Evelyn Leavitt. They had had a couple of bad boards in the first session, and Evelyn, always the pessimist, was sure they had a very poor score. After Dave checked the scoresheet, Evelyn asked how they did. "Sorry, we failed to qualify," Dave replied. When Evelyn went up to get her consol-

ation entry, the director asked her what she was doing there. "You're leading the field," he told her. Evelyn didn't think it was funny at first, but it became a good deal more humorous when she and Dave went on to win the event.

When he's not playing bridge, Treadwell spends his time playing blackjack and working on the "magic rectangle" --- a figure composed entirely of squares of different sizes. The minimum number of squares is nine, with only one possibility. With 10 squares, there are more possibilities, and so on. Treadwell has developed magic rectangles with up to 15 squares --- about 2500 --- using a computer and a mathematical formula.

Treadwell has won hundreds of regional championships to go with two major titles --- the North American Swiss Teams in 1982 and the Master Mixed Teams in 1985.

The election process will change for future elections. Whereas this year the top three vote getters were elected, in 1999 only the top vote getter will be assured of entry. Other new members, to a maximum of two in the living category, must be named on at least 50% of the ballots.

Yes, that's the bidding as Virgil saw it. Clearly it wasn't a make -- down four -- minus 200.

Before play started, the opening leader asked Virgil, "What's two clubs?"

"Strong, artificial and forcing," Virgil replied.

"Even over an opening 1NT?"

That's right -- South had opened 1NT -- she didn't pass. Virgil just didn't see the 1NT bid.

By the way, Virgil got above average. A couple of pairs bid and made 3NT, and several more doubled 2♠ and collected a 300-point penalty.

## Alvin Landy

The 1998 recipient of the *von Zedtwitz Award*, recognizing contributions to the game of bridge through bridge-playing expertise, is Alvin Landy, Life Master #24 and longtime ACBL chief executive.

A Cleveland native, Landy was a graduate of Western Reserve University. He also earned a law degree from the school in 1927. He practiced law in Cleveland until 1943, when he served in the Army Transport Command during World War II.

Landy joined the ACBL as a tournament director in 1948. He had previously worked as a freelance director for years, and was referred to as a "national director" long before the position of a salaried national TD actually existed.

In 1951, Landy was named acting business manager of ACBL when his predecessor, Russell Baldwin, was called for active duty during the Korean War. Landy, who was in charge of the day-to-day business of ACBL, worked with the legendary Al Sobel, who was named tournament manager in the same year. An article that appeared in a 1951 *Bulletin* noted: "These top-flight national directors will continue to conduct tournaments despite their added responsibilities."

In December 1952, Landy was named executive manager of the ACBL. He remained in that capacity until his unexpected death from a heart attack in 1967 at the age of 62.

Landy's 16-year tenure as the top executive for the ACBL was marked by rapid growth in the membership and a stable administration. Landy was named ACBL Honorary Member of the Year in 1957.

In addition to these contributions, Landy served as secretary of the ACBL Charity Foundation from the time of its inception, and was a principal figure in its creation. Through his efforts, the Foundation grew to a \$250,000 annual project by 1967.

Landy served as Secretary of the ACBL Laws Commission from 1956 until his death.

Landy was also active in the World Bridge Federation. He was one of its founders and first officers, serving as secretary-treasurer from 1958 to 1966.

As a player, Landy was widely recognized for his skill and expert play. He won several major events. His first was the American Bridge League's Knockout Team Challenge in 1936. He later scored four wins in the Fall NABC Men's Teams, a record. Landy was a member of the winning Spingold Knockout Team in 1949, playing with teammates Jeff Glick, Arthur Goldsmith, Bruce Gowdy and Sol Mogal. He was second in the event twice.

Landy was also the originator of the convention that bears his name: a 2♣ overcall of an opposing 1NT bid to request that partner bid a major. In fact, many bridge players are most familiar with the name of Landy because of this simple and effective two-suited overcall.

## Prunes

Today's fruit snack will be prunes, courtesy of Unit 460 (Sutter Buttes CA). California produces 70% of the world's prune production and the Sacramento Valley produces more than 80% of California's crop.

Yuba City CA, home of Unit 460, is located in the heart of prune-growing country and is the site of California's annual Prune Festival held in mid-September.

John Lowenthal was the victim on two hands from the qualifying sessions of the Mixed Pairs, but he was a gracious loser, praising his opponents for their play.

Lowenthal was playing with Gail Stanhope. Their opponents were Ellasue Chaitt and Bruce Reeve. Reeve led a low heart, won with dummy's king. Lowenthal led a low spade to his 10 and Reeve ducked. Reeve won the spade continuation with his ace, cashed the ♦A and continued with a low diamond. Lowenthal ruffed in dummy and led a low club to his king. Reeve won the ♣A and led the ♦K, ruffed in dummy.

Now Lowenthal had to get back to his hand to draw the remaining trumps. He could ruff a spade low and hope not to be overruffed, he could ruff a spade high and hope trumps weren't 4-1 or he could play a low club to his jack.

"You can guess which one I chose," said Lowenthal. "It was a heck of a defense."

Lowenthal encountered a problem of a different kind in the second qualifying session. His opponents were Bill Sides, who won the Silver Ribbon Pairs earlier this week, and Beverly Rosenberg.

Lowenthal led the ♠5 to the 2 and 3 as Sides ruffed. Sides played a low club to dummy's jack and ruffed another spade. He cashed the ♥K and led another club. Lowenthal won his ace and, in an effort to cut down on ruffs, led a heart. Dummy's 10 won the trick and Sides led a low diamond.

Stanhope ducked and Sides' queen won. He led a diamond to the ace and ruffed a spade with his last heart. He cashed a club and had to score his tenth trick with dummy's ♥A.

"What could we do?" asked Lowenthal. "He had 10 tricks and we couldn't do a damn thing."

# Derailed by discard

It appears there's no way to beat the notrump game, but David Lindop made a play that put declarer on the wrong track. The well-conceived discard swung 19 IMPs.

Lindop led his fourth best club, and declarer ducked when Joey Silver played the king. Silver continued clubs, and declarer started on diamonds, crossing to the ace and finessing on the way back, losing to the jack. Lindop tested spades by winning the king, but shifted back to clubs when Silver gave a discouraging signal.

Declarer won and cashed his diamonds. Lindop could see what was coming -- his ♥Q was trapped. So he tried to muddy the waters by discarding a heart at his first opportunity. This did NOT escape declarer's attention. He was certain Lindop did not have the ♥Q, so he played for a defensive mistake. He crossed to the ♥K and led back the jack, passing it. Lindop gobbled the trick with his queen and cashed out for down three, plus 300.

At the other table, Lindop's teammates bid and made 2NT. As a result his team picked up 10 IMPs. If West had made his game, Lindop's team would have suffered a 9-IMP loss.

# Finessing a 5

Dave Arthur, husband of Entertainment/Charity Chairman Elaine Arthur, isn't a bridge player but he was caddying in the Intermediate/Novice area. "I have to go to work," he explained to Matthews, "but I'll come back if I can work in this room. These people are nice." Matthews assured Arthur he would be welcome in the I/N room any time.

Also welcome -- not just in the I/N room -- were 20 members of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees. The group is donating all caddy fees to the Association's local chapter with half of that amount going to Alzheimer's research.

Another welcome addition to the caddy corps is Bernice Gee, wife of Canadian bridge pro Ken Gee. Her first stint was in St. Louis where Matthews recruited her for Reno. It wasn't difficult. "I play at regionals, but it's like a holiday to me to come to the NABCs," she said. "These guys (the other caddies) are doing a superb job."

In fact, Gee and four other caddies -- Alex Maynard, Tev Johnson, Jay Craviotto and Patrick Malarkey -- are averaging three to four sessions a day. "They're good about taking naps and coming back," said Matthews.

Matthews was expecting to be short-handed -- "no spring break of any kind" -- but she wasn't expecting 800 tables. She needed 33 caddies on Tuesday and she had 23 available.

Working out of an office that houses 18 boxes of apples, six boxes of bananas and 14 boxes of pickup slips, Matthews set out to recruit additional caddies. The result: "I now have 10 former friends working as caddies today," she laughed.

Matthews is excited about the new combination of caddies and player/caddies. "I have people looking in every day, asking if I need help."

She also thinks the players are becoming more considerate of caddies. "Caddy, please" is now a common call. "We all answer to caddy but we prefer to answer to our last name: Please," Matthews said.

## A lesson in humility

Sometimes one gets so intrigued by exotic possibilities that one forgets to attend to business. That was the case on Board 26 from the second final session of Open Pairs I.

I was East, declaring 3NT. South led the ♥2 and North won the ♥A K and returned a heart. I won the ♥J, pitching a club from dummy.

There was no hope of establishing dummy's club suit -- that would give the defenders at least one club to go with three hearts and the ♦A. Driving out the ♦A would bring my total up to seven tricks -- after that, I could try a club finesse and maybe locate the ♠J.

When I led the ♦K, North won the ace and led his last heart. I threw the ♦2 from my hand the another low club from dummy. South won the heart and shifted to the ♣J. I held my breath and the ♣Q held the trick.

Now what? Cashing the ♣A could squeeze North in diamonds and spades. Cashing three spades, ending in hand, could squeeze somebody in diamonds and clubs. Cashing the ♠K A Q and then diamonds might squeeze somebody in spades and clubs.

Electing the second option, with the added possibility of the ♠J coming down, I cashed the ♠K, A and Q, noticing that South showed out on the third spade, pitching a diamond. Cashing two diamonds failed to exert pressure on anybody and I led a club to the ace for down one.

A more observant technician might have noticed, however, that the ♦6 was good. It pays to watch the spots.



# Gwozdzinsky-Wexler defenders in Women's

New Yorkers Margie Gwozdzinsky and Susan Wexler will seek to combine aggressive bidding with accurate defense and claim their second victory in the 67th annual Women's Pairs competition here at the Spring NABC in Reno.

The pair was so aggressive in winning the contest last year in Dallas -- by nearly three boards -- that they claimed Wexler's bid box held only one pass card.

"Once we got to game, our opponents were not going to get a good result," said Gwozdzinsky. When the opponents sacrificed, they got a worse result.

When Wexler led the ♦9, Gwozdzinsky took her ace and returned the ♦3, suit preference for hearts. Declarer won the ♦Q and led the ♣Q. Wexler ducked and Gwozdzinsky took her ace. She shifted to the ♠K and declarer won the ace. Now declarer led the ♣J, and Wexler took her king and led a low heart.

Gwozdzinsky cashed the ♥Q, ♥A and ♠Q. When she next led the ♦J, Wexler's ♣9 was promoted for the fifth undertrick.

Plus 1100 was worth all 25 matchpoints.

## Whitehead Trophy

Gwozdzinsky and Wexler, second in the Women's Pairs at the 1996 Spring NABC in Philadelphia, will be vying to have their names inscribed a second time on the Whitehead Trophy, donated in 1930 by one of the world's greatest bridge authorities.

Wilbur C. Whitehead of New York was a member of the team that won the Vanderbilt Cup in 1928, the first year it was in play.

Whitehead (1866-1931) was president of the Simplex Automobile Company, but bridge held such a fascination for him that he retired from business in 1910 to devote his whole life to bridge.

At the time, he was living in France, where he wrote his first book, *Royal Spades*. A second book was published in London in 1913.

His first book to appear in America was *Whitehead's Convention of Auction Bridge* in 1914.

He was the inventor of many of the outstanding conventions of bidding and play, the quick-trick table of card values, the Whitehead system of requirements for original bids and responses, and the Whitehead table of preferential leads.

Whitehead was instrumental in standardizing procedures in auction bridge and later in contract bridge.

The Women's Pairs was the first national event won by Helen Sobel Smith -- she was Helen White

when she and Helen Bonwit won the title in 1934. Smith went on to win again in 1938 and 1939 with Sally Young.

The Women's Pairs was also the first national title for Edith Kemp Freilich, who as Edith Seligman won in 1941, 1942 and 1943 with Mae Rosen. Freilich also won with Sally Young in 1946, Virginia Heckel in 1966, her sister Anne Burnstein in 1979 and Nancy Gruver in 1986.

Kay Rhodes and Margaret Wagar hold the record for consecutive wins in the Women's Pairs -- they won in 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.

**The Facts:** There was an agreed break in tempo before South doubled 3♠. N/S called for the Director when East bid 4♣. The Director later ruled that pass was not a logical alternative to bidding 4♣. The table result stood.

**The Appeal:** N/S appealed the ruling. They suggested East's hand had enough defense to make pass a logical alternative to bidding 4♣.

**The Decision:** The Committee changed the contract to 3♠ doubled, making three, for N/S +730. Law 16A prohibits a player from choosing from among logical alternatives one that could be demonstrably suggested by extraneous information. West's break in tempo before doubling 3♠ demonstrably suggested doubt about defeating the contract, and was extraneous information. East had no reason to believe 4♣ would be more successful than 3♠, doubled. He earlier chose not to compete to 4♣, so pass must be a logical alternative. In 3♠, doubled, it was clear that declarer would take nine tricks (4 spades, 1 heart, 2 diamonds and 2 club ruffs).

The Committee discussed the appropriate time to call the Director in hesitation cases. Laws 9A and 9B require the Director to be called when attention is drawn to an irregularity. The issue was whether the hesitation or the bid that possibly used the information from the hesitation is the irregularity. The Director and one committee member felt the hesitation is the initial irregularity. The majority believed Law 16A makes using the extraneous information the irregularity.

**The Facts:** E/W play that opening 1NT shows 12-15 HCP balanced, but denies holding both major suits (may have one). N/S were confused by the explanation. North doubled the Stayman bid intending it as takeout, but there was no such agreement with South. She said to the Director after the hand was over that she would bid 2♥ if East passed. (South did not attend the hearing)

South led the ♣8, won by East with the ♣10. The ♦Q was won by North's Ace, who led three rounds of hearts. East cashed the ♦K and J (discarding clubs from dummy), then led the ♠A, Q and 10. North later won a spade and heart. The Director was called when play was completed. West told the Director he would have bid 3NT if he knew the double did not promise clubs. The Director ruled there was a failure to Alert the double of 2♣. The violation affected the auction and may have affected the play. The Director ruled Average Plus to E/W and Average Minus to N/S.

**The Appeal:** N/S appealed. They suggested there was no agreement about the meaning of the double. The poor result was a product of poor play, and not from any failure to Alert.

**The Decision:** The Committee decided that the table result (E/W +120) would stand. There was no violation because N/S had no agreement about the meaning of the double. The Committee felt that South's club lead indicated she expected her partner to have clubs. North doubled to show cards, but the Committee felt he would have doubled if his and the West hands were interchanged.

The passing of Hideous Hog had temporarily left the bridge world without a beloved, gregarious, and sometimes controversial figure. The loss of HH was felt, not only by the world of bridge, but also in the form of a world-wide recession driven by the instantaneous collapse of both the corn market and the coffee shop industry.

Everyone is forced to deal with death in a personal manner. Fortunately or unfortunately, top bridge players decided to celebrate HH's life in a manner only HH could appreciate. The players decided to create as much controversy as they possibly could. To wit:

In the spirit of true "full disclosure," one top team proposed a plan to provide every match with matching private bathrooms, one smoking, and one non-smoking.

Sent into a tailspin by the recent turn of events, retro players decided to create their own time warp and bring back the stalwart pair of the original Precision Team – Sontag-Weichsel.

The best filly in the field decided her true advantage might lie in polo. Accordingly, she saddled up only four horses and left the rest in the stable. Admiration was disguised by cries of heresy.

Turning to the action, in their earliest exit ever, out went Nickell in the round of 32, the last run of the most successful team in American bridge since the Four Aces. Congrats to Miles for earning the distinction of being the last team to defeat Hamman and Wolff. Meanwhile, teams unable to beat the best American teams continued the trend begun in the late 1980's -- scouring the WBF scene for the best foreign pairs.
